Call for papers

Teletandem is an autonomous and collaborative online context of interaction through a webcam that uses VOIP technology (such as Zoom, Meet, etc.) to facilitate intercultural contact between people from different countries (Telles, 2009). The session takes place for one hour which is in turn divided into two parts; during the first one, both students converse in the language of one of the participants about a defined topic and do so in the language of the other participant, thus making the practice balanced, enriching and collaborative, allowing both to practice in an interactive way.

In this context, the Autonomous University of Hidalgo State, UAEH in Mexico will be hosting the 3rd edition of the International Meeting on Foreign Language Learning in Tandem (IMFLIT), titled 'Challenges and new directions in virtual exchanges environments' on March 26-28, 2025.
